We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for the Central Elementary. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as "HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS". We are VERY proud of this label.

Although each year all our students continue to show much growth, various subgroups of students struggle to meet state expectations. Those subgroups include students who qualify as economically disadvantaged, limited English proficient (LEP) or students with disabilities. Our staff values continuous improvement and is committed to utilizing best practices and personalizing learning to meet the needs of individual students. Ensuring that our students have a guaranteed and viable curriculum, effective instructional framework and a multi-tiered system of support are key strategies that will lead to higher levels of student performance. In addition, maintaining a safe and orderly environment

and working closely with our parents and community is essential to reaching our goals. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in our improvement efforts. By working as an educational team, we are confident that our school can become a leader in education in the state.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL – Central Elementary assigns students to its school based on district geographic boundaries. The school also participates in the Kent Intermediate School District schools of choice program, the State of Michigan Section 105c schools of choice program, and Section 6 student transfer process.
2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN – Central Elementary participates in the Michigan Department of Education’s continuous improvement process. 3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL – There are no specialized schools within Central Elementary. However, the building offers a variety of supplemental services through Title Ia, 31a, Title III, and Title Ic grant funds.

The CCSS are a set of national standards that aim to allow for more in-depth learning and a focus on skills and competencies demanded in the 21st Century.
